Spend Management Services: Operational Budgets

Course Description

This course provides a structured and practical examination of operational budgeting as a central discipline within the controllership function. Operational budgets are a spend management and governance tool, controlling spend at the job, project or departmental level. Note: Woodard's CAS model considers financial budgets and forecasts to be a function of FP&A Services.

Designed for early-career and experienced accounting professionals alike, the course bridges foundational budgeting concepts with modern practices in financial governance, operational planning, and policy-based expenditure control.

We will explore how budgets support strategic decision-making, how to construct and maintain policyaligned budgets, and how to use budget data to identify variances, mitigate risks, and mitigate cost and expense overruns.

- Analysis of Variances
- Mid-Cycle (or Mid-Project) Reforecasting and Operational Strategic Adjustments
- Detecting Non-Compliance or Gaps with Purchasing and Spend Policies

Session Four – Budgeting as a Strategic Spend Management Tool

- Linking Budgets to Metrics and Strategic Objectives
- Budgeting for Risk and Contingency Planning
- Integrating Budgeting with Employee Spend, and/or Procurement Systems
